Six COM members served at BMH this past June for two weeks. Guys did construction, general cleaning, woodworking, painting, plumbing, electrical, small engine repair, bicycle repair, landscaping, grass cutting, weed eating, etc. Ourladies worked in a very large and nice thrift store folding linens, stocking andpricing items to sell to the public. The store last year sold over \$1.2m in goods. They also worked in the café located within the thrift store building. Additional information regarding BMH: The requirement for volunteers is to workat least 6 hours per day, 4 days a week. They provide NO meals as childrenreceive their meals in their respective homes. However, the café serves breakfast and lunch items at a reasonable cost. Located next to the campsites is an air-conditioned lodge containing a fully stocked kitchen, TV, internet, laundry, showers, screened porch with grill and fireplace.
