The ladies were busy with their sewing machines and made 109 dresses, 39 masks, 12 pants, 9 walker bags, 5 short sets 17 oven gloves, and 19 aprons. Also, they almost entirely painted the entire building on the inside with two coats of paint. The church fed us lunch each day and out of the 23 days we had lunch they did not duplicate the menu once. So much for the New Years resolution for losing weight. We had a devotional each day and prayed for each other as almost half of us were sick for a while during the project. Mr. Zion served us a fried fish dinner for our last meal there and then presented Alabama Campers on Mission a donation of \$2500. A good project, lots of good eating and a pay forward from the church to another project. We will be going back in May to help finish flooring and fixtures.
