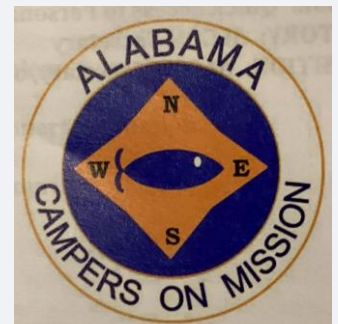
Please be in prayer for our Nominating Committee as they begin to canvass our membership in hopes of finding those who will serve as the next officers.
