

**Shocco Springs  
April 10th - 21st 2023**

**We had 43 workers, some only 1 day, but it was a busy and productive time. We had three new members working on their first project. Gary and Kay Moran attended their first rally and expressed interest in working on a project and was able to come to Shocco Springs, Glenda Lee was a first-time volunteer and actually joined COM while working at Shocco. The women started our week off helping with approximately 450 Consumers at Shocco, helping in Food Services and The Station. The men built a 20 x 20 storage building at the picnic area. At Bagley 3rd floor removed duct insulation and Replaced 88 switches and receptacles and cleaned conference rooms and hallways. Shocco Inn cleaned construction debris and installed 80 lights, reset 8 toilets, formed sink tops and made 8 barn doors. Constructed 12 benches, 7 firewood boxes and 4 half picnic tables for Gilbert Hall outside dining. Replaced rotten steps at Isbell, replaced rotten wood at Puckett. At the preschool building, pressure washed and painted exterior, replace trim woodwork and 9 exterior doors and painted. Moved wall back 16 inches and worked on windows at Twin Lodge. The women worked with the Consumer Group on Monday through Wednesday in the Station and Food services. Laundry every day after Consumers left. Put on Bedspreads at Oakridge and Springview. Cleaned windows and rails at Oakridge and Springview. Took pictures down from the walls in Oakridge and Twin Lodge. Stained 17 benches and 8 picnic tables. Several ladies made 57 book bags for Shocco to take to Ecuador on their Mission trip. We had a hot dog supper and ice cream social.**
